*“Blessed are you who are poor,  
for the kingdom of God is yours.  
Blessed are you who are now hungry,  
for you will be satisfied.”  
- Luke 6:20-21a*

**PEOPLE OF THE RESURRECTION**

In the past few weeks we have been hearing about the beginning of Jesus' ministry as written in the Gospel of Luke. Jesus began his ministry in the synagogue in Nazareth by reading, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me / because he has anointed me / to bring glad tidings to the poor." (Luke 4:18) With those words, Jesus announced the whole purpose of his ministry. He himself was to bring the kingdom of God to the poor. This is the good news of salvation that he preached and brought about during his ministry.

Today we hear the Beatitudes, in which Jesus explains more fully what those "glad tidings" really mean. The good news is about salvation from suffering on earth and in the life to come. It is about divine favor resting on those who trust in God's love and mercy, rather than on those who trust in human plans, possessions, and power.

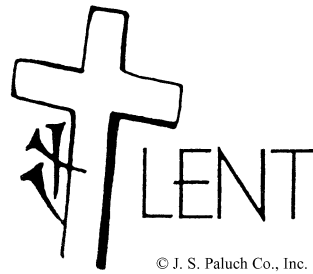

# LENTEN SCHEDULE AND REGULATIONS



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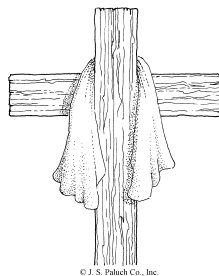
Next Wednesday is **Ash Wednesday**, the beginning of the Lenten Season and a day of Fast and Abstinence. Masses will be celebrated at **St. Julie's at 8:00 am, 12:00 Noon, and 7:30 pm**. Ashes will be distributed at all Masses.

During Lent, Catholics are required to fast and abstain on certain days in imitation of Jesus' fast in the desert. Church law defines "*fasting*" as eating one regular-sized meal and two small meals. "*Abstaining*" is refraining from eating animal flesh. Church laws are designed to guide a broader range of people in various states of life. We are always welcome to go beyond the minimum by perhaps engaging in a more vigorous fast, abstaining from another food if you are a vegetarian, or fasting an extra day during the week.

**ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY:** Days of fast and abstinence. Limit of **ONE** full meal for all who have reached their 14th year until age 59, and no meat is eaten.

**WEEKDAYS OF LENT:** No obligation to fast; however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

**DAYS OF ABSTINENCE;** All Fridays of Lent. (All who have reached their 14th year are called to abstain totally from meat.)
