**EASTER SUNDAY: RESURRECTION OF THE LORD
APRIL 4, 2010**

**“To him all the prophets bear witness,
that everyone who believes in him
will receive forgiveness of sins through his name.
- Acts 10:43**

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

We all know what to expect of Easter: lots of lilies around the altar, our "Alleluia" joyfully sung over and over, perhaps a tasty ham dinner later in the day, topped off by some chocolates from the Easter basket. But all of this began, as we hear in today's Gospel, with the "unexpected" when Mary Magdalene found the tomb empty. Indeed, Peter's speech from Acts in the first reading could insert the phrase "you might have expected" at a number of points . . . that Jesus would baptize John, not the other way around . . . that his healing and exorcising ministry would win him acclaim, not death . . . that his resurrection would place him in another dimension, not back at table with his followers. On a day like Easter, a day filled with traditions, customs, and expectations, we are called more than ever to keep looking for God's will in unexpected places, people, and events. In this way, we can continue to give witness, like Mary Magdalene and Peter, that Christ is truly risen from dead and continues to live among us.
